We do not have any grade-level classroom teachers in the pipeline to return or arrive for July 2023. This means that for the 2023-2024 school year, we currently do not have any lead classroom teachers for Grades K-5.

Please pray that God will mobilize teachers and that God will give wisdom to the entire UIS admin team – that we will be creative and wise as we think outside of the box, and that we will make decisions that ultimately glorify Him, even if they do not look like the fully staffed school we have come to expect.”


