A majority of Solos speakers live in the inland and northern villages and use a different dialect than the people along the southern coast that we have lived and worked among for the past ten years. In terms of making a useable Bible translation for all the Solos people, this presents a problem.

When the book of Joshua is published and we get feedback from the main villages, we should be able to get a clearer idea of how certain things might need changed. Meanwhile, our August and September survey trips have given us some idea of the perceived differences across the Solos area.

One thing that took us by surprise was a group of men and women in Gagan village who were

determined to start a translation team to be able to serve the whole Solos area better. There have been a couple of attempts to start work there before, but various (continued on Back Page...)
