Our last segment of the Translators' Training Course 1 still needs to happen as well, but with Christy being out of country, it has been delayed. Pray that we would be able to find the right time to hold the last two weeks of the course and get these new translators (as well as the old ones) working on Genesis. Ask for open doors!
